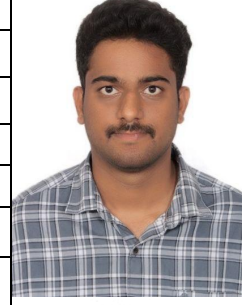

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES (Please read the instructions carefully):

1. **Candidates are advised not to write anything on Admit Card before coming to the examination centre, otherwise their entry to the examination centre will not be permitted.**
2. **Candidates are required to bring their admit card along with a valid photo ID proof in original** (Voter card, PAN card, Aadhaar card, Driving license, Passport etc).
3. Candidates who do not bring the admit card and photo Identity card will not be permitted to appear in the examination. **Xerox copy of photo ID proof will not be accepted.**
4. **Paste your recent passport size photograph (identical to the one uploaded) in the space in admit card & sign across it.** Also append your signature in the space provided in presence of the invigilator.
5. Candidates are advised to make sure about the location of their examination centre well in advance.
6. **Candidates would be permitted inside the venue between 0930 hrs. to 1030 hrs. Entry would not be permitted inside the venue after 1030 hrs,** under any circumstances, whatsoever.
7. **Candidates are also required to reproduce the given statement in the space provided in the admit card only after entering the examination room / in presence of the invigilator and provide his/her Name, Date and Signature.**
8. The candidate must write the answers using **blue ball pen** only.
9. The candidate has to appear at the allotted centre only, failing which his/her candidature will be cancelled.
10. Candidates may have to undergo frisking at the exam centre. No candidate will be permitted to leave the examination centre before 1200 Hrs.
11. Total duration of Tier-II exam is one hour i.e. from 1100 Hrs to 1200 Hrs. Time from 1030 hrs to 1055 hrs will be used for distribution & filling up of answer sheets, marking of attendance, collection of admit cards, etc.
12. Appearance in the Tier-II exam is, however, provisional and does not entitle the candidate any claim for appointment to the post/s. Qualifying the Tier-II exam is subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria.
13. While signing the attendance sheets, please ensure that you sign against your name only. If there is any spelling mistake in the name or whatsoever, the same should be brought to the notice of invigilator in writing but the candidate must not alter/change his/her name either in the admit card or in the attendance sheet.
14. The answer sheet will not be replaced in any circumstances.
15. **Before leaving the examination hall, please deposit your admit card & answer sheet to the invigilator. Failure to do so would result in cancellation of candidature.**
16. The candidate can carry the question paper after conclusion of the examination.
17. Prohibited items like books, paper chits, magazines, electronic gadgets (mobile phones, tabs, smart watches/bands, Bluetooth devices, head phones, pen/buttonhole camera, scanner, calculator, scanning device, etc even in switch off condition) are strictly prohibited inside the examination room. If any such item is found in possession of a candidate, the same would be confiscated & candidature cancelled in addition to legal/criminal proceedings against the candidate.
18. The arrangement for safekeeping of valuable/costly items at the venues cannot be assured.
19. If any candidate is found using unfair means or violating any instructions or found involved in any undesirable activity including creating disturbances at the exam venue, his/her candidature shall be summarily cancelled. Such candidate shall also be liable to be de-barred from future examinations.
